Year one



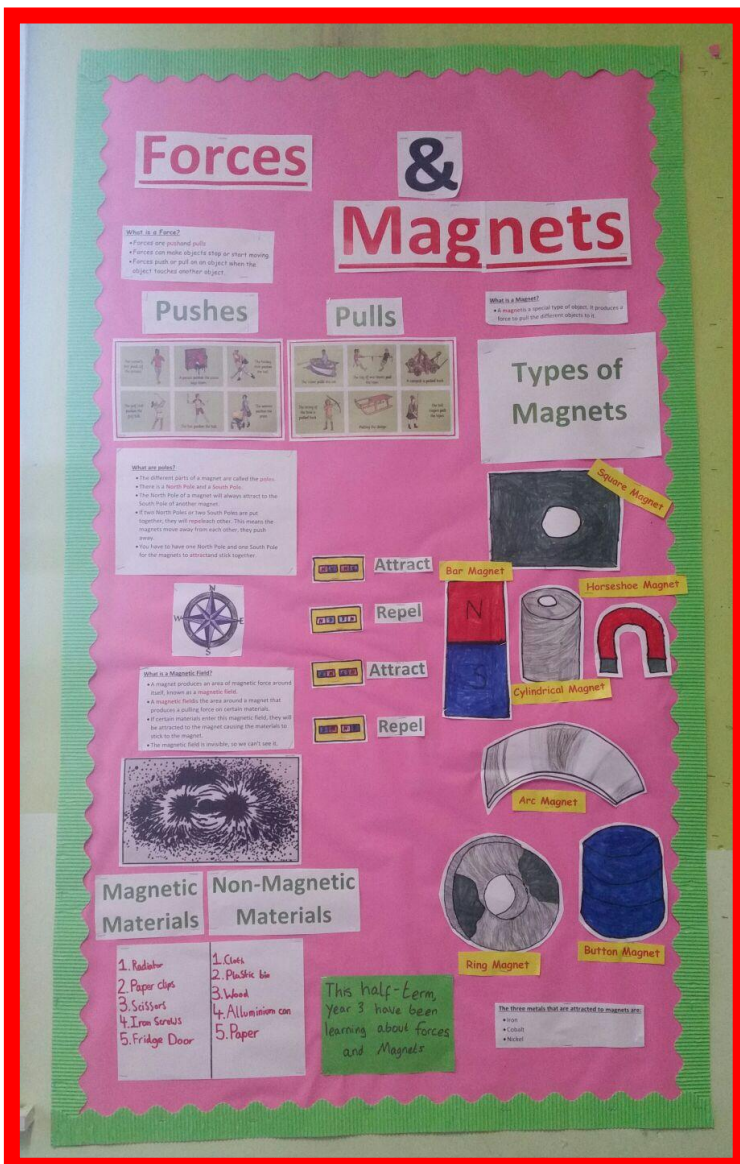
This term the year 1 class have been learning about a variety of common animals including: fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

Year 3

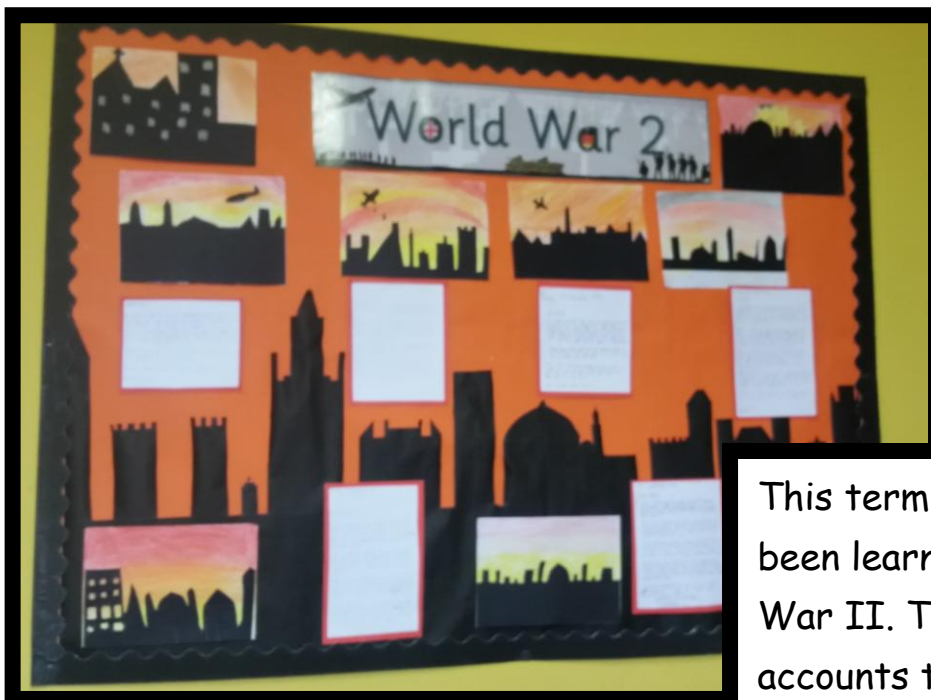
The year 3 children this term have been learning about forces and magnets.
