You may amend/update your data as and when you wish.

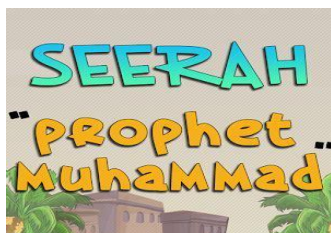
